# **Holiday Activities and Food Programme (HAF)**

This summer, Blackpool FC Community Trust are offering a free provision to children who attend Waterloo Primary Academy. The Government funded 'Holiday Activities and Food' programme (HAF), is designed to support families that find it hard to access holiday clubs. During the first five weeks of the summer holidays, school will be open between 9am - 1pm, providing four hours of provision and a healthy meal at no cost. Spaces on the programme are limited and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. If parents require additional childcare, then a 'bolt on' offer will be available for parents to book an additional 2 ½ hours of camp, at a cost of £5 per day. All bookings must be placed using the booking link which will be made available next week.**
