Waterloo@120

On April 11th 1904, Waterloo Primary Academy first opened its doors to 88 pupils, so this year will mark 120 years of Waterloo! As you already know, we are intending to celebrate this event with a range of activities and memorabilia.

As part of our celebrations, on **Thursday April 11th** (first Thursday back), we are inviting the children to dress in clothes relevant to the Edwardian era (see the letter which was sent home earlier this week). During the day, the children will participate in a variety of activities associated with schools from the early 1900s. After school, from 3:30pm until 4:30pm, parents will be able to view photographs, log book entries and learn more about the history of the school. The display will be situated in the Old Hall.

On **Friday April 12**th, the children will be able to dress in their own 'party clothes' as we will be holding a special birthday lunch with music, decorations and food.

All children who normally have a school dinner, will automatically be catered for, but we sent a letter home offering any children who normally bring a packed lunch, the opportunity to purchase a one-off school lunch for this event, should they wish to do so. The deadline for responding was today. If you have missed the deadline, and your child would like a birthday lunch, please see your child's class teacher on Monday. After this point, we will no longer be able to accommodate any further orders.

End of Term Arrangements

This term seems to have raced by! A reminder that school will close for the Easter holidays next **Thursday (28th March) at 1pm**. This change to our normal hours means that **there is no after school club on that day and no afternoon session in Nursery**. When we have an early finish, we often have children who are left behind. We politely ask that all children are picked up promptly on Thursday. **Our last day will be a non-uniform day in school**. If you have any outstanding payments, we politely ask that these are settled before the end of term.

Just a reminder that the new term begins on **Monday 8th April 2024** at the normal time. Please note, we do not have a 2-week holiday at this time of year, so our children should return to school on Monday 8th, regardless of the holiday pattern of any other siblings
