## CHRISTMAS AT WATERLOO!

Dear Parents and Carers,

Christmas is just around the corner and there is a great deal going on over the festive period in school. I have tried to put all the information that you need into one letter, but do ask any of the staff if you have any questions.

# **Nursery Stay and Play**

The children and staff in Nursery are looking forward to sharing their Christmas Stay and Play with parents and carers on **Friday 13<sup>th</sup> December from 2pm-3pm**. All Nursery children are invited to attend, even if Friday is not one of their regular days in school.

## **Wriggly Nativity**

The Reception children and their staff team are working incredibly hard to put together their Wriggly Nativity. The children are really enjoying learning the songs and trying on their costumes. There will be three performances for families of the Reception children, which will take place on **Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> December** (Cherry Class), **Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> December** (Willow Class) and **Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> December** (Oak Class). All three performances will start at 9.30am in the Sports Hall. As the rest of the children in school will be busy working, we are politely asking anyone coming to watch the Nativity, to use the Harris Avenue entrance to the Sports Hall. We will open the gates at 9.20am, which will give everyone time to be seated ahead of the performance. After each performance, we will be taking a retiring collection in support of Brian House.

### **Christmas Jumper Day**

On **Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> December**, we will be holding a Christmas jumper day in school. The children are invited to come to school in a Christmas jumper/non-uniform, in exchange for £1 each or £2 per family. All the money raised will be donated to Brian House. Brian House is a local charity who provide specialist care and support for babies, children and young people who have a life-limiting condition. They are a local hospice, and this particular charity holds a special place in the hearts of the Waterloo staff family. We thank you in advance for your generosity.

### **End of Term Arrangements**

This term has been an extremely busy one in school. The children and the staff have worked incredibly hard and we are extremely proud of all that they have achieved. Your children really are taught by the most wonderful staff team and we are grateful for all their dedication and hard work.
