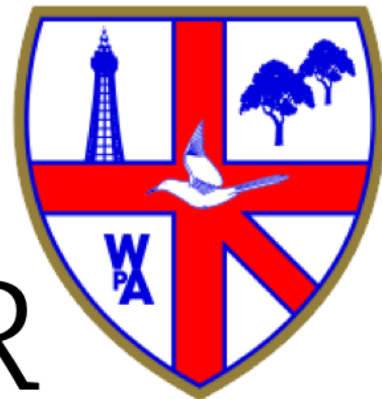

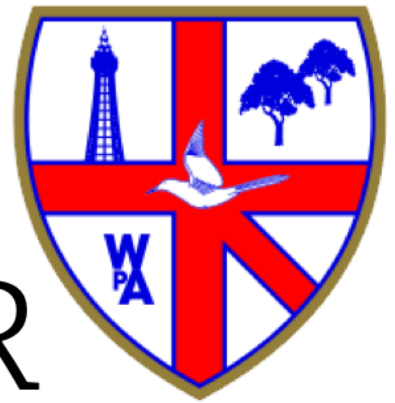

Mrs Nicola Cowling - Year 3 Teacher

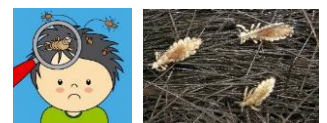

Headlice advice...

There are many products on the market to treat head lice. Head lice and their eggs can be removed by wet combing. You can buy a special fine-toothed comb from pharmacies to remove head lice and their eggs. Firstly, wash hair with ordinary shampoo and after apply lots of conditioner. Comb the whole head of hair, from the roots to the ends, it helps to clip the hair up and do the combing in sections. Make sure you repeat this process over the next few days and be checking regularly. You must do this even if you have used a medicated treatment on the hair. Wet or dry combing regularly can help catch head lice early and help to stop them spreading to other people.
