



Schools receive PE and sport premium funding based on the number of pupils in years 1 to 6.

Funding is determined based on data from the January 2016 school census.

Waterloo Primary Academy's funding allocation for 2016 – 2017 was £10,655, received in two payments, May 2017 and November 2016.

How we spent our money?

Waterloo Primary Academy continues to have a well-developed PE department that caters for the needs of all children regardless of their ability. The funding provided by the government continues to enhance the outstanding range of opportunities pupils are given in sporting and educational outdoor activities.

Other uses of the funding:

- To continue to employ 3 specialist sports coaches to work alongside teachers providing high quality PE lessons
- Purchase of additional PE resources for the academy's new sports hall
- Sports coaches timetabled to work with pupils in the schools after school club
- Sports coaches timetabled to provide a variety of Enrichment Activities
- Sports club activities continue to run before school
- Additional members of staff undertaken to undertake a variety of PE qualifications
- To continue to work in partnerships with the local football club to promote healthy lifestyles – fit2go
- To provide Sporting Holiday Clubs
- Engage all children in intra and inter school competitions in the throughout the academic year.
- Provide children access during fitness week to an extensive range of sporting activities.

How we will sustain our improvements

The academy continues to enhance sporting facilities, equipment and will sustain the number of sports coaches employed by the academy.

The new purpose built sports hall has now been completed and the academy will pursue grant funding for a climbing wall.
